The Venue is Ashton Playing Fields, Chigwell Road, Woodford Bridge, IG88AA

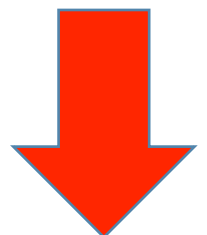
